If you arrive before 3:10pm to pick up your student, you will be directed to park in the parking lot and wait for your student. We can't block Tucson Marketplace with our car line. If you don't want to wait in the car line, you are welcome to park in one of the dirt lots to wait for your student. You may not park on Tucson Marketplace to pick up your student as this blocks traffic. Thank you for assisting us with ensuring a safe arrival and dismissal for everyone. We appreciate you working with us as we navigate the parking situation.
- Please review the student handbook and dress code information. Only water bottles are allowed in the classrooms. Any outside food or drinks must be consumed in the event center before class. Students will be asked to place cell phones in a phone caddy in their classrooms. We promote professional skills on our campus and encourage students to dress for success.
