I hope you are having a great week so far. The next two weeks are testing weeks for all students. Thursday, April 3rd will be a full day of testing. Freshmen will be taking the ACT Aspire, Sophomores will be taking the Pre-ACT, Juniors will be taking the AzSCI test, and Seniors will be completing their CPR graduation requirement. The standardized tests must take place in person. It is imperative for students to be on time to school on test day. Students arriving after 8:30am will be placed in a classroom for the entire testing period (all day) and have to make up the test on assigned make up testing days. Students will not be permitted to have cell phones, smartwatches, or earbuds for the duration of the test. Testing will conclude approximately at 11:45am. If you need to pick up your student early from school, please do not do so before 11:45am. Students who leave in the middle of the test day will not have the opportunity to make up the test. After lunch, students will attend all 6 of their classes with shortened time and dismissal will be at 3:16pm. There will be no after-school tutoring Thursday, April 3rd. April 8th, 9th, and 10th our Juniors will take the ACT in small groups. Our school letter grade is impacted by how students perform on the test.

It is imperative we have all students on campus on Thursday, April 3rd for testing. Thank you for supporting your student and our school for a successful testing week. Please review the details below regarding testing:

For 9th grade families, here are the details about the ACT Aspire Test:

- April 3rd will be the test day. April 16-24th will be make up test days.
- ACT Aspire is for 9th grade students only. It must take place in person.
- It is imperative for students to be on time to school on test day. Students arriving after 8:30am will be placed in a classroom for the entire testing period (all day) and have to make up the test on assigned make up testing days.
- Students who finish the assessments will be required to sit quietly in class until all students have finished.
- No cell phones, smartwatches, or earbuds will be permitted.
- It is important for students to get a good night's sleep the day before the test and eat a good breakfast.
- Lunch will be served at 11:50am for the entire campus.
- The test includes the following components: English, Math, Reading, Science, and Writing For 10th grade families, here are the details about the Pre-ACT test:
 - April 3rd will be the test day. There will not be a make up day for this test.
 - Pre-ACT is for 10th grade students only. It must take place in person.
 - It is imperative for students to be on time to school on test day. Students arriving after 8:30am will be placed in a classroom for the entire testing period (all day) and will not be able to make up the test.
 - Students who finish the assessments will be required to sit quietly in class until all students have finished.
 - No cell phones, smartwatches, or earbuds will be permitted.
 - It is important for students to get a good night's sleep the day before the test and eat a good breakfast.
 - Lunch will be served at 11:50am for the entire campus.

For 11th grade families, here are the details about the AzSCI test and ACT:

- April 3rd will be the test day for the AzSCI test. April 4th 11th will be make up test days.
- AzSCI test is for 11th grade students only. It must take place in person.
- It is imperative for students to be on time to school on test day. Students arriving after 8:30am will be placed in a classroom for the entire testing period (all day) and have to make up the test on assigned make up testing days.
- Students who finish the assessments will be required to sit quietly in class until all students have finished.
- No cell phones, smartwatches, or earbuds will be permitted.
- It is important for students to get a good night's sleep the day before the test and eat a good breakfast.
- Lunch will be served at 11:50am for the entire campus.
- The test includes the following components: Science concepts
- Your student will take the ACT on either April 8th, 9th, or 10th. April 11-17th will be make up test days.
- ACT is for 11th grade students only. It must take place in person.
- It is imperative for students to be on time to school on test day. Students arriving after 8:00am for their assigned ACT day will have to make up the test April 16-18th.
- It is imperative for students to be on time to school on test day. Students arriving after 8:30am will be placed in a classroom for the entire testing period (all day) and have to make up the test on assigned make up testing days.
- Students who finish the assessments will be required to sit quietly in class until all students have finished.
- No cell phones, smartwatches, or earbuds will be permitted.
- It is important for students to get a good night's sleep the day before the test and eat a good breakfast.
- The test includes the following components: English, Math, Reading, Science, and Writing For 12th grade families, here are the details about the CPR Graduation requirement:
 - CPR certification is an Arizona State Requirement for High School Students to graduate.
 - April 3rd will be the test day.
 - It must take place in person.
 - It is imperative for students to be on time to school on test day. Students arriving after 8:30am will be placed in a classroom for the entire testing period (all day) and will not be able to make up the test.
 - Students who finish the assessments will be required to sit quietly in class until all students have finished.
 - No cell phones, smartwatches, or earbuds will be permitted.
 - It is important for students to get a good night's sleep the day before the test and eat a good breakfast.
 - Lunch will be served at 11:50am for the entire campus.
