All seniors participating in the commencement ceremony must attend rehearsal in order to participate in the evening ceremony. Graduation is on Thursday, May 22nd at 7:00pm. Our commencement ceremony will be held at Kino Sports Complex - North Soccer Stadium. There isn't a limit to the number of guests each graduate may bring; however, seating is first come, first served. You will not be able to reserve seats. Gates will open at 6pm. There will be a Clear Bag Policy that is strictly enforced for all attendees. No bags, no backpacks, no purses will be allowed in the graduation area. All guests are encouraged to carpool as
